
CONGRATULATIONS to Tilly, Scarlett, Hugh & Monty

It is always a sad moment when I need to report the passing of a resident or someone close to Quandialla.

An even sadder time when I am reporting the passing of a young soul.

It is with a very sad heart that I report the passing of Bradley James Nixon age 22 years late of Wagga.

Brad fought a valiant battle against bowel cancer but sadly passed away on Thursday 14th March.

Bradley's great grandparents Herb and Vera Nixon with their 5 children relocated to "Montrose" Quandialla in 1948. Brad's grandfather Kevin helped his father with farm work over the following years, and in 1964 married Ruth Symonds from Young and raised their 3 children on the new family farm "Sunnyside". Brad's father John was born and raised in Quandialla but moved when he married. In 1998 "Sunnyside" was sold to the Broomby family and today the Nixon name has disappeared from our community but there are many descendants of this respected name far and wide that still call Quandialla home.
