## QUANDIALLA RECYCLING SERVICE

The Quandialla Recycling Service has been available to our community since April 2014 and we have been recycling without too many problems over that time. But it does happen that a bin will not be collected due to unsuitable items being placed in it. When this happens, “*someone*” needs to go through the bin, take out those items and dispose of them elsewhere.

One such time happened this week, and two bins were left behind. A local recycler found those bins and tried to rectify the problem. Collecting over 30 water bottle tops, plastic containers without the correct code plus polystyrene boxes, but unfortunately there was too much for her to handle.

### Just to recap on the rules for recycling:

The bins are only comingled (mixed) recycling, with the rules of use detailed below and also stamped into the bin lids. All liquids should be drained from bottles, cans and containers and lids removed. Food scraps, garden waste, lawn clippings or alike are NOT recyclables and MUST NOT be placed into the recycle bin under any circumstances. If you are in doubt to recycle it or not, then don't risk the contamination and place it in the normal waste.

### ITEMS YOU CAN RECYCLE – YES

**Plastics:** all plastics codes 1-7, ice-cream & takeaway containers, milk bottles, juice & cream containers, cordial bottles.

**Aluminium & Steel:** all empty steel cans, aluminium soft drink cans, clean aluminium foil & pie trays, empty aerosol cans.

**Paper & Cardboard:** telephone directories, newspaper & magazines, cardboard, cereal & food boxes, office paper, envelopes & office mail.

**Glass:** all empty glass bottles & jars

**Cartons:** empty milk & juice cartons

### ITEMS YOU CANNOT RECYCLE – NO

Food scraps – Plastic bags – Polystyrene – Nappy – Crockery – Syringe – Ceramics – Cookware – Garden waste

**Unsuitable waste being placed in the recycling bin will result in the bin not being collected, as one contaminated bin can spoil an entire truck load of recycling. Please recycle correctly at the Quandialla Depot and do your bit to save valuable resources.**
