BLAST FROM THE PAST Extracts from IDLE CHATTER

Extract from IDLE CHATTER Vol. 2 No. 14

THURS. 1st August 1957

BLAND ELECTRICITY – In an effort to find means of supplying the area East of the Bland Creek, the Electrical Engineer of the NRCC together with those of the Young Municipal Council and the Bland Shire Council conferred. As a result, the President of the Bland Progress Association (Mr CD Brown) has now been told that the NRCC have requested all distributing authorities adjoining the area to conduct preliminary surveys of certain portions and to submit the estimated costs. The servicing of such extensive area by any one body would present a major financial difficulty, far in excess of its permissible loan quota for any one year. Should however there be two or more bodies involved, the raising of the loan money could be spread and the whole project could then be handled on a collective basis.....

RURAL ELECTRICITY – Loan money is available, and labour will be ready to commence the Berrendebba- Quandialla-Roundhill circuit in about three months' time. My appeal to come and mark off your homes on the maps at my office has met with much success. Is your name down? The sooner this list goes into Grenfell the sooner you will be enjoying the comforts of bulk electricity. Remember, the more consumers there are the cheaper it will be for you.....
