Friday, 12th April 2019.

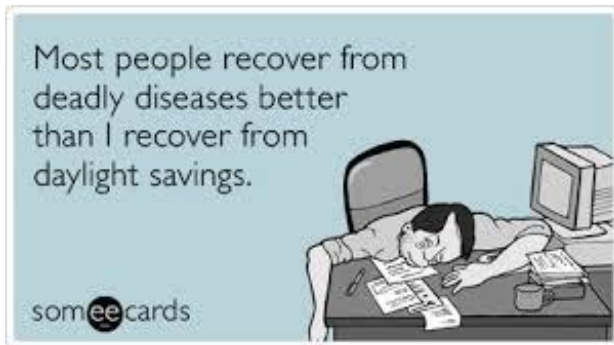
