2021 ANZAC DAY

Our CENOTAPH stands on the front portion of the Soldiers Memorial Ground next to the Quandialla Soldiers Memorial Hall facing Second Street. When the Cenotaph was erected in 1953 it was placed in front of the old hall ready for the new hall to be built. The Cenotaph was erected to carry the names of the citizens who served in World Wars I & II, with the Cenotaph as the focus of the Memorial Park.

Fifty names of men who served in World War I are honoured on this simple obelisk, ten of whom did not return. The names of service-personnel from World War II and Korea are also listed.
