At 14 years of age Lindsay was shearing for the Causer neighbours, was a keen horse rider and when he left school, he joined the family tank sinking business. Lindsay married Heather Moore, who was the daughter of the Station Master at Quandialla in 1944. After share-farming through two severe droughts, Lindsay and Heather moved their young family, John, Robert, Jennifer, Roslyn, Graham and Stephen, to Wollongong, where he worked at the BHP Steel Works as a Shift Foreman at By-Products until his retirement.

Lindsay did move away from Quandialla many years ago, but still has fond memories of the place where he was raised, and Quandialla will always remain in his heart.

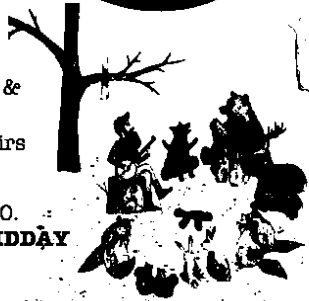
