ONE HUNDRED YEARS AGO

The following Article was in the
Grenfell Record and Lachlan District Advertiser (NSW: 1876-1948)
Monday 13 June 1921.

CORRESPONDENCE (To the Editor of the Grenfell Record)

Dear Sir, -

During the last three weeks the Shire Council's men have been trying heroically to complete their work on the Bimbi - Quandialla Road, between the 25 and 26 pegs. To one who knows the country it is difficult to understand the Council's actions in sending these men to this district at the beginning of winter.

They possess a very poor idea of the conditions to be faced if rain occur. Owing to representations being made by the Farmers and Settlers Association and Progress Association, it was promised that the above work would be put in hand not later than last February. By trying to top up the forming at spot mentioned they have succeeded in ruining this bit of road for the rest of the winter.

The whole of the work promised to be carried out last February will now have to be abandoned. Everyone in the district is pleased to see the Council start the work, but there is no reason why a little common sense should not be used if it were only for the benefit of the unfortunate contractors.

The spreading of about 1000 yards of metal at Quandialla was commenced about the middle of May last year, and before it was finished the whole of the traffic from Bimbi side had to face the worst piece of road one could imagine owing to it being cut up by the heavy traffic.

After this experience it seems strange indeed that the Council should be responsible for a further outrage on the public convenience in this manner.



When I read the above letter, I had to laugh because I am sure all our readers would have had a similar experience with road works or projects that sometimes seem like an ongoing saga with their local council and watching said jobs end up costing more than what was budgeted.
