It is with great sadness that I report the passing of Mrs Lillian Reeves nee: Hill, late of Young on Thursday 5th July aged 97 years.



Lillian's parents, Peter and Mary and brother James left Wigan, England and arrived in Sydney on the 18th March 1911. The family headed to the Kelso district and eventually moved to Grenfell where Lillian was born on the 5th January 1921.

The Hill family moved to Quandialla in the early 1930's and Lillian attended the Quandialla School and then completed her secondary studies in Grenfell. Lillian married Sims Reeves in 1947 and had three children Anne, John & Jillian. In 1994 Lillian and Sims retired from farming with Lillian eventually making her home in Young.
